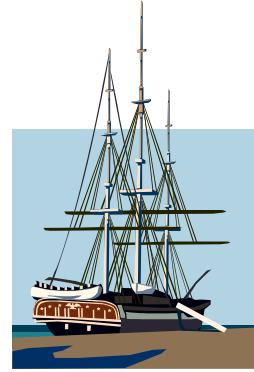


CONSTITUTION CUP Sailing Instructions

Saturday, July 6th, 2019
A Mass Bay Qualifying Race



Two Races (if possible)

2.1 & 2.2 ELIGIBILITY/ENTRY: In accordance with MBSA Season Championship splits. One Design starts will be designated by their class flag or class insignia. Register online at www.regattaman.com or by mail by sending entry fee and valid ORR-EZ certificate to:

2.3 FEES: \$60. Mass Bay Sailing or U.S. Sailing member discount \$5.00. . Pay on line www.regattaman.com or make checks payable to Boston Harbor PHRF. **Entries must be received by July 5th. On the water entries will be surcharged \$10.**

2.4 HANDICAP SYSTEM: ORR-EZ Time on Time will be used.

3. RULES: This event will be governed by the MBSA General Sailing Instructions except as changed by these Event Sailing Instructions, which will be posted on www.cpyc.org and www.regattaman.com.

Boats are required to check-in before their first start of the day with boat name, sail number and number of souls on board. Boats in the racing area that are not starting a second or subsequent race must notify the Race Committee before leaving the racing area. Boats that withdraw from racing must advise the Race Committee as soon as reasonably possible.

4. NOTICES TO COMPETITORS: Will be posted on the official notice board located at CPYC, on the Regatta Management Solutions website www.regattaman.com, and the CPYC website, www.cpyc.org.

5.3 CHANGES TO THE SAILING INSTRUCTIONS: Will be posted at CPYC, on www.cpyc.org and www.regattaman.com

6.1 SIGNALS TO COMPETITORS: Signals made ashore will be displayed at CPYC and announced on VHF 72. (Should weather dictate abandoning the regatta prior to the rendezvous, or moving the race area, the RC will make an announcement at approximately 1000 hrs. by VHF, text and email.)

7.1 SCHEDULE OF RACES: Maximum of 2 races.

7.2 STARTING SIGNAL: First warning signal 1200 hrs.

9. RACING AREA: Rendezvous in the vicinity of MBSA Racing Mark "M", Boston Entrance Gong RW"NC" at 1130 hrs.

10.1 THE COURSE: Intended courses to be used are MBSA standard courses or MBSA List of Marks "A".

11.1 MARKS: Marks will be inflatable tetrahedrons and/or government marks (List A).

13. THE START: Starts will be in accordance with RRS 26.

14.2 RECALLS: The Race Committee will use VHF channel 72.

17.1 & 17.2 TIME LIMIT: 3 hrs. after the actual starting time of each class. The finishing window shall be 30 minutes after the first boat in each class finishes.

19. PROTESTS: Written protests must be filed on the appropriate form and filed within 24 hours by emailing to the Fleet Governor at www.regattacomittee@cpyc.org Details of the hearing will then be provided as soon as possible.

20. SCORING: The low point system will be used.

24. PRIZES: Prizes for top three places depending on the number of entries in each class will be presented at the CPYC Annual Awards Night to be held in conjunction with Mass Bay Sailing Awards dinner at CPYC on Friday, November 22, 2019
