5.2 Date of racing: Saturday, June 15, 2024

One Race is scheduled.

Scheduled time of **the warning signal** for the first boat to Start is 1155.

6. CLASS FLAGS

6.1 Class flags will be displayed **only for the first boat(s) to start the race:**

All Classes Pink

8. THE COURSE

8.1 The course will be as shown as one of those in Appendix A, B, or C of the NOR.

9. MARKS

9.1 The starting and finishing marks will be an **orange** tetrahedron and an orange flag on the signal vessel. **This changes RRS Appendix S Para 11.1**

11. The START/FINISH

11.1 The starting and finishing line will be between a staff displaying an orange flag on the RC Signal Vessel and the course side of the nearby red tetrahedron starting mark. Boats are permitted to start and finish in either direction. **This changes RRS Appendix S para 11.1**

11.2 For the purposes of the rules, each boat's STARTING SIGNAL shall be her Starting Time and her PREPARATORY SIGNAL shall be four (4) minutes prior to her starting time. By RRS definition, each boat is racing at her preparatory signal and RRS 42 applies.

11.3 The Racing Committee will attempt to hail the sail numbers of OCS boats. The order, timing, and success of these hails shall not be grounds for redress. This changes RRS 62.1 (a).

16. TIME LIMITS AND TARGET TIMES

16.1 Time limits and target times are as follows:

Race Time Limit	3 hours – Time limit for the first boat to sail the course and finish.
Finishing Window	60 minutes – Time limit for boats to finish after the first boat sails the course and finishes.

16.2 If no boat has passed their chosen first "Bridge" mark (Mark G/C or Mark M/N) within 1 Hour of their starting time, the race shall be abandoned. Failure to meet the target time will not be grounds for redress. This changes RRS 62.1(a).

16.3 If no boat has sailed the course and finished within the race time limit, the race shall be abandoned. Failure to meet the target time will not be grounds for redress. This changes RRS 62.1(a).

16.4 Boats failing to finish within 60 minutes after the first boat sails the course and finishes, and not thereafter retiring, being penalized, or given redress, will be scored TLE (Time Limit Expired, see Scoring). (This changes RRS 35, A4, A5.1, A5.2 and A10)

18. SCORING

18.1 Scoring for the regatta will be based on the boats' finishing position in each Class if so designated.

22. PRIZES

22.1 Prizes for each CLASS will be awarded for the RACE based on FINISH POSITION as follows:

- 5 or more boats: 1st – 3rd place.
- 4 boats: 1st – 2nd place.
- 3 boats: 1st place.

22.2 Awards Ceremony

Time and location will be broadcast on VHF channel 72 prior to the start of the race.
