
KHYC 2022 TWILIGHTS

Sailing Instructions



Second Half June 30 -September 15, 2022

Revised 3/17/2022



2. ENTRIES:

- 2.1 Boats must be entered via Regatta Management Solutions by 5pm on the day of the race.
- 2.2 An entered boat must declare its intent to race by sailing past the committee boat before it's warning.
- NOTICE TO COMPETITORS: Notices To competitors will be posted on the Regatta Management Solutions Board by 1700 on the day of the race.
- 4. SCHEDULE OF RACES: Schedule of races is described in the Notice of Race.
- 5. CLASS DESIGNATIONS: Class designations are described in the Notice of Race.

6. THE COURSE:

- 6.1 All courses will be selected from KHYC TWILIGHT RACE CHART 2022.
- 6.2 Course signals will be displayed from the Race Committee Boat by placard at the Warning Signal for the next Class to start.
- 6.3 The start line is restricted unless starting. Boats already started shall not pass through the starting line on course to "The leeward" mark while the committee boat is starting other classes. Boats ducking the line to restart once declared OCS are exempt from 6.3 until started.

7. START:

- 7.1 Races will be started in accordance with Racing Rule 26 with Classes starting in the sequence described in the Notice of Race.
- 7.2 The starting line will be between an orange flag on the Race Committee boat and an orange flag in the water, in the vicinity of "S".
- 7.3 A boat whose Preparatory Signal has not been made shall keep clear of all boats whose Preparatory Signal has been made. Boats violating this rule may be disqualified.

8. RECALLS:

- 8.1 Individual recalls will be signaled in accordance with Racing Rule 29.1. The Race committee may hail sail numbers on VHF Channel 78. If no hail is given, **this is not grounds for redress.**
- 8.2 General recalls will be signaled in accordance with Racing Rule 29.2. The class being recalled shall go to the end of the scheduled class starts

9. Finish

9.1 The "Finish Line" will be at the harbor entrance on a line of sight between the "Orange Flag" on the Race Committee Boat and the "Redondo Beach East Jetty Light 2". A racing boat shall be finished when the Race Committee Boat acknowledges with a sound. "W" mark is a mark of the course and shall be left to port. 9.2 The Race Committee Boat will be on station until 2000 hours. Boats finishing after that time will take their own time when crossing the finish line (@ W mark) and without delay advise the Race Committee via Ch. VHF 78 or cell phone 310-971-6081 9.3 All boats that are flying Spinnakers at the finish, must release a "control line" promptly at the finish line.

9.4 **Boats** retiring from the race must advise the Race Committee without delay, either on Ch. 78 VHF or cell phone 310-971-6081.

10. PENALTY SYSTEM:

The "Two Turn Penalty" is replaced with a "One Turn Penalty"; modifying Rules 44.1 & 44.2. Rule 44.3 shall not apply.

11. PROTESTS:

Protests must be on written <u>Protest Form</u>, available at the KHYC website, and filed within 30 minutes after the Committee boat docks. Protests will be heard as soon as possible after the conclusion of each race.

12. SCORING:

The Low Point Scoring system will be used. See Notice of Race.

13. RADIO COMMUNICATIONS:

The Race committee will monitor VHF Channel 78.
