



**Notice of Race**  
**2024 True Blue Spencer Evans Regatta**  
**Blue Hill, Maine**  
**Host: Kollegewidgwok Yacht Club**



**July 21, 2024**

**1. Rules:**

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*.
- 1.2 The International Laser Class rules apply with the exception of Non-ILCA class sails which may be used if they are built according to the ILCA handbook and are made of Dacron, mass produced and readily available.

**2. Eligibility and Entries:** The event is open to all ILCA4, ILCA6 and ILCA7's of the ILCA International Laser Class Association. Sailors shall wear a Type III PFD or other approved buoyancy aid at all times on the water. Competitors must be able to swim and to right a capsized boat and be able to climb into the righted boat from the water.

**3. Classes:** There will be two Classes scored for the regatta. The ILCA4's and ILCA6's together will make one Class and the ILCA7's will make the other Class. All ILCA classes will start together.

**4. Event Schedule:**

11:30am	Competitors meeting
1:00pm	First warning signal
4:00pm	No races to be started after this time

**5. Registration and Fees:** All registrations must be completed through Regattaman.com. Entry fee for the regatta is \$ 35.00. Saturday's competitors' dinner will be a Lobster dinner and will be an additional \$30.00 for each attendee. **6. NOTICES TO COMPETITORS & CHANGES IN THE SAILING INSTRUCTIONS:** Notices to competitors will be posted on the official noticeboard located in the KYC clubhouse. Changes to the Sailing Instructions shall be posted by 11:00am on Sunday July 21st.

**7. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS:** The Sailing Instructions shall initially be posted on the Regattaman website and any changes to the instructions will be posted on the official noticeboard.

**8. COURSES and MARKS:** As described in the Sailing Instructions.

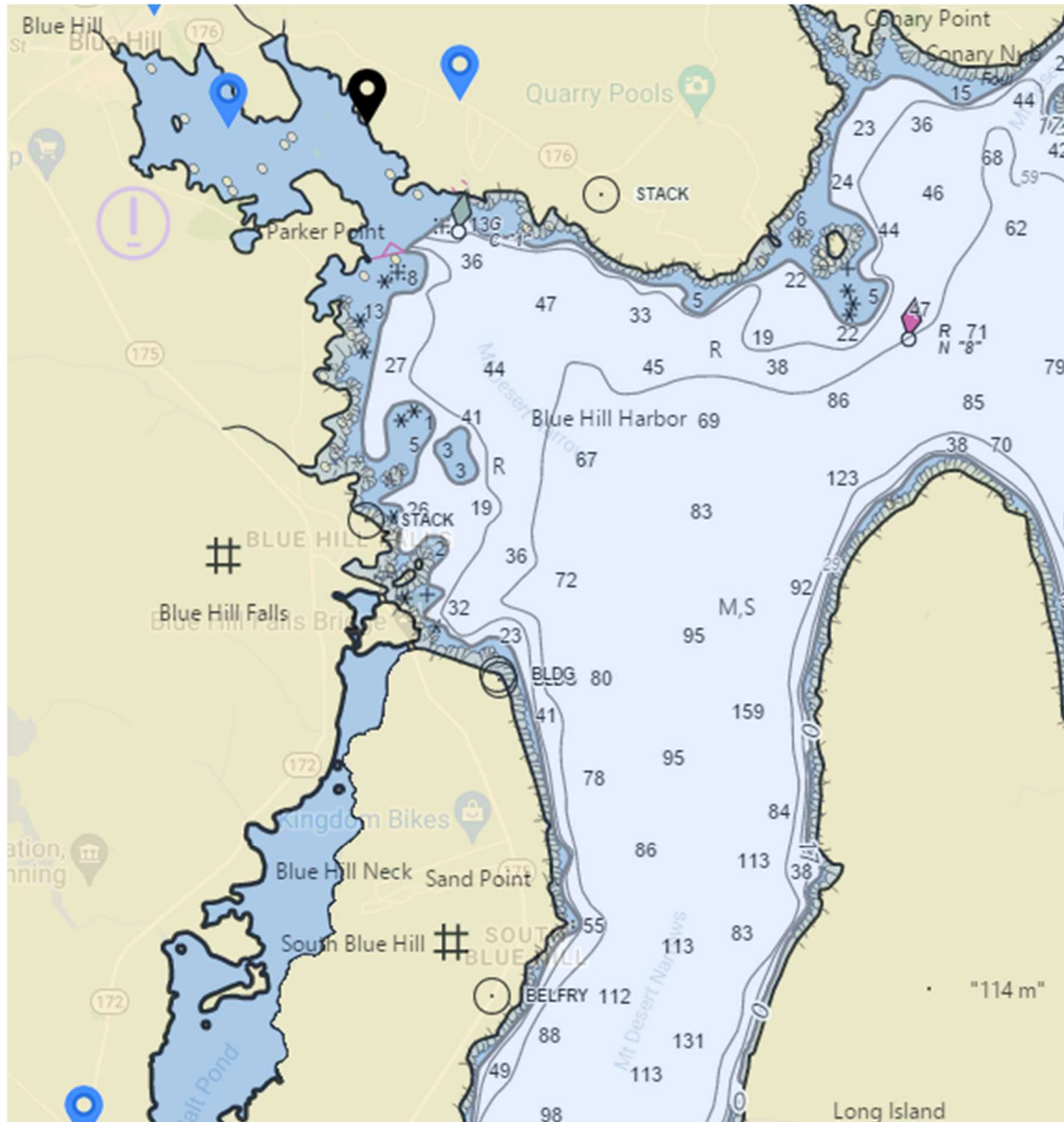
**9. PROTESTS:** Boats intending to file a protest or request redress shall notify the Race committee Boat after finishing the race during which the incident occurred. This modifies RRS 61.3.

**10 POST-RACE PENALTIES and EXPEDITED HEARINGS:** US Sailing Prescription Appendix T - Alternative Procedures for Dispute Resolution, Sections B - Post Race Penalties and C - Expedited Hearings shall be used.

**11. SCORING:** A Low Point Scoring as per RRS Appendix A. 2 races are required to have a series. There will be one discard after 5 completed races.

**12. Disclaimer of Liability:** Competitors participate in the regatta at their own risk. See rule 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

**13. RACING AREA:** Blue Hill Harbor, short sail from the KYC Club
